

Requirements for the Greek America Foundation's Hellenic Legacy Scholarship

- Student must be currently enrolled in an accredited U.S. or Canadian institution of higher education.
- Student must be accepted by DEREЕ – The American College of Greece for a semester abroad. To apply visit: <http://www.acg.edu/study-abroad>
- GPA of 3.0 or better
- Completed scholarship application (see attached)
- Additional materials that must accompany application include (a) current transcript, provided by ACG upon authorization (b) resumé, and (c) two letters of recommendation. Materials may come separately but must bear the complete name of the applicant.
- 450 word personal statement that answers the following questions: *What motivates you to spend a semester in Greece? What do you hope to gain from the experience? How will you make the most of your experience once you are back in the U.S.? What does community mean to you?*
- Students will be required to present their experiences in various Greek America Foundation print and digital media (blogs, video and other promotional materials).

The scholarship will cover tuition and excursions for one semester (up to 15 credits) at the DEREЕ-The American College of Greece. For students enrolled in one of DEREЕ-The American College of Greece's partner institutions, the scholarship is valued at 4,000 Euros and will be applied to DEREЕ's comprehensive study abroad fee.

PLEASE NOTE: *Successful applicants will be required to cover their own room and board while in Greece and to take at least two courses (6 credits or more) related to Greece or Hellenism.*
