



DEREE Merit Scholarship Program

DEREE – The American College of Greece is proud to announce the DERE Merit Scholarship Program open to outstanding high school graduates. With this program, recent graduates who have achieved excellent grades in high school will receive an automatic tuition reduction at DERE based on the following scale. The program is also flexible and allows students to pursue parallel studies, that is, simultaneous attendance at DERE and a Greek university.

Tuition Reduction	High School Grades/GPA
50%	19/20 95/100 3.8/4.0 and above IB: 40/45 and/or 7, 7, 6 in HL courses or equivalent grade
35%	18 – 18.9/20 90 – 94.9/100 3.6 – 3.79/4.0 IB: 36/45 and/or 7, 6, 6 in HL courses or equivalent grade
25%	17 – 17.9/20 85 – 89.9/100 3.4 – 3.59/4.0 IB: 32/45 and/or 6, 6, 6 in HL courses or equivalent grade

To be eligible students must:

- *Have graduated from a high school in Greece within the current academic year*
- *Have achieved a GPA of at least 17*
- *Register for at least 2 courses and maintain that course load throughout the semester*

To continue receiving the award students must:

- *Achieve a Cumulative Index (CI) of 3.0/4.0 by the end of the second semester and maintain it throughout their studies*
- *Complete their studies within 6 years*

Please note that:

- *Non-degree students are not eligible*
- *Non-credit courses are not covered by the scholarship*
